Good news from the West Dried Meat Lake Regional Landfill Site. In addition to inert waste, burnables, scrap metal, tires, white goods, waste oil and electronics, the landfill now accepts:

- all types of batteries (for recycling)
- paint (some kinds can be recycled)

The landfill is open to the public Tuesdays and Saturdays from 8:45 am to 3:15 pm. And remember, May is FREE month - dump just about anything without paying any of the usual charges.

The Centra-Cam paper recycling shed is very popular. Please help by sorting and bundling your newspapers, magazines, and cardboard. It makes emptying the shed a lot easier.

Meter Readings

New Water Meters

We now have about 20% of the new meters in place.

These customers will never have to read their water meters again (and never pay \$10 for forgetting to).

With the new water pipeline nearing completion, we will be using an installation company to finish the job.

The Village office will be contacting everyone to make an appointment for the installers. We hope to be finished by the beginning of July.
