## EXCITING NEWS FOR THE VILLAGE....

With last winter's freeze-up of the Village's main water line, Council has implemented a multi year plan to make major repairs to the aging lines. The first stage will be to replace the line along MacQuarrie Ave. **NU EDGE CONSTRUCTION of Camrose** has been awarded a \$320,000 contract to replace the **main water line along MacQuarrie Ave**, and to re-construct the affected pavement. They will also fix the other two sections of pavement dug up from last winter / spring's water line freeze-up. Construction will commence in November. The water line is to be completed before Christmas, with the roadwork is to be completed in the spring/summer.

Temporary water services will be provided to all those affected, and there may be detours around the construction site. Watch for updates on notice boards in the store and the Village office.

As a project of this size and cost has only been a dream from the Village's perspective, it is with pleasure that **we sincerely thank the Provincial Government** for grant funding from Alberta Transportation and Municipal Affairs. Without their support, this project would not have been possible.
