

## **Flower Section**

1. Gladioli... 1 spike (approximately 1/3 stem with 2 bottom leaves, 1/3 open florets and 1/3 top with buds showing color and closed buds.)
2. Dahlia... (5 in. and over) 1 bloom and 1st leaves Remove buds.
3. Dahlia... (under 5 in.) 3 blooms. Include 1st set of leaves. Remove buds.
4. Rose... Hybrid, 1 bloom (no buds)
5. Rose... Floribunda, 1 spray, at least 2 open blooms, 1/3 buds opening and 1/3 buds closed.
6. Hardy Rose... 1 stem (see above standard)
7. Petunia... Single, 6 blooms
8. Petunia... Double, 3 blooms
9. Petunia... Ruffled, 3 blooms
10. Pansy... 6 blooms
11. Viola... (under 1 in) 6 blooms
12. Aster... 3 stems
13. Sweet Pea... no foliage, 6 stems
14. Marigold... (under 2 in.) 6 blooms
15. Marigold... (2 in. and over) 3 blooms
16. Snapdragon... 6 stems, remove seed pods
17. Any Annual Not Listed ... 3 stems (name if possible)
18. Annual Collection... separated (5 or more varieties)
19. Perennial Collection... separated (this means each variety in its own container) Name if possible.
20. Arrangement in Novelty Container
21. Tea Cup Arrangement... under 8 in. in any direction
22. Coffee Table Arrangement... under 6 in. tall
23. Table Arrangement... no more than 15 in. tall, may be viewed from any side.
24. Buffet Arrangement... flowers face front
25. Flowering House Plant
26. Foliage House Plant
27. Succulent or Cactus
28. Potted Begonia
29. Potted Geranium
30. Mixed Planter
31. Any perennial not listed 32. Lily... 1 stem

## **Vegetable Section**

1. Beans, Yellow... 6 pods, stem attached
2. Beans, Green... 6 pods, stem attached
3. Peas... 6 pods, stem attached
4. Beets... 3, roots and top trimmed to 1 in.
5. Cabbage... 1 head, including some outer leaves
6. Carrots... 3, over 3 in. and under 7 in., no greening on crown, 1/2 in. top and root left on
7. Cucumber, Slicing... 2, (1/2 in. stem attached)
8. Cucumber, Pickling... 3 (1/2 in. stem attached)
9. Corn, half husked... 3 cobs
10. Potato, White or Yellow... 3
11. Potato, Colored... (pink, red, purple, blue)
12. Potato, Russet or Netted Gem... 3
13. Tomato, Green... 3
14. Tomato, Ripe... 3
15. Onion, from sets... 3 (flat shape, stem and roots trimmed to 1/2 in. Do not peel.)
16. Onion, from seeds... 3 (globe shape, stem and roots trimmed to 1/2 in. Do not peel)
17. Squash, Marrow, Zucchini, or Pumpkin... 1
18. Any Vegetable Not Listed ... 1
19. Apples... 6, wiped, stem attached
20. Crabapple or Apple- Crab... 6, wiped, stem on
21. Rhubarb... 3 stalks (leave 1 in. of leaves)
22. Fruit Display... at least 3 varieties, artistic presentation

## **Children's Section - 14 years and under**

1. Vegetable Collection... at least 6 varieties
2. Novelty Vegetable... as grown
3. Flower Arrangement
4. Novelty Arrangement... may use flowers or vegetables or both
