### MATERIALS DIVERTED AND RECYCLED:

**Tires** – All tires must be sorted and stacked in appropriate areas

**Scrap Iron** – placed in appropriate bins

**Used Oil** – in collection tank

**Oil Filters and Oil Jugs** – 25 litres or less

**Pesticide Containers, Batteries, White Goods, Concrete, Paper and Cardboard, Electronics, Paint** – in 25 litre pails or less, conditions apply

**\*\*Inert Materials** – Inert materials are defined as non-toxic or non-hazardous waste

Some acceptable inert materials:

**Construction/Demolition** – Wood, Drywall, Ceramic and Clay Bricks, Glass, Trees and Branches, Roofing Materials including Shingles, Tar or Plastic Vapor Barrier

**Waste Sand or Gravel**

**Furniture**

**Plastics** – including plastic siding trimming, plastic moulding, plastic bags, plastic twine, polyethylene sheeting

The classification of inert material may be revised periodically in order to ensure compliance with the Alberta Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

The WDMLRLA reserves the right to conduct random load inspections.

No liquid waste will be accepted at the West Dried Meat Lake Regional Landfill.

Contaminated soil will be accepted by application only and must meet AEP standards before disposal.

All wastes must be deposited as directed. Failure to follow operator's directions will result in charges for removal and proper placement of wastes.
